The whole house had to be covered in black plastic and vacated for the demolition period.






WHAT A TRANSFORMATION THIS WAS AT FORSTER KEYS

One really cool change was when we removed the window in the vanity area and installed a shaving cabinet. They are becoming extremely popular because they are a perfect storage option. Shaving cabinets aren't very expansive coming in at around \$400.

As clients move more towards wall hung vanities they are losing storage and this is one reason we are seeing the rebirth of the shaving cabinets.
